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TEA

We source our teas very carefully through Kiona Malinka based in Europe and Nana Chan based in Hong Kong with an aim for not just quality, but justice for the farmers and artisans that produce them. Perhaps this story by Kiona can explain why:

“A month ago I went to South Africa to find a good rooibos because it was something that I didn’t love that much. The whole rooibos market is all small bags and low quality. I found this elderly farmer who was working organically after having searched for four days, and I asked him if I could taste his tea. He began crying and said: “Nobody ever asked me if they could taste it before buying it. They all place orders before the harvest – everything is finished off and everything is really cheap.” We believe we can do better.

WHITE

Yabao Wild – *Yunan, China* 120
Exceptional wild white tea harvested 1,200 above the sea level showing subtle notes of yellow fruits and dried flowers.

Bai Hao Yin Zhen – *Fujian, China* 140
Made from the young, fuzzy and plump tea leaf buds, Bai Hao Yin Zhen, otherwise known as “Silver Needle”, has a fresh and floral aroma with a delicately sweet and honeyed flavor.

GREEN

West Lake Longjing – *Hangzhou, China* 100
An authentic Longjing from the Meijiawu area around the Western Lake – a village with 600 years of history of tea cultivation made from an old plant of a rare Qunti Zhong cultivar.

Gyokuro – *Uji, Japan* 160
A vibrantly fresh loose leaf Japanese green tea prized for its savory, umami flavor and a thick broth-like texture.

OOLONG

Min Jian – *Taiwan* 120
Sometimes referred to as “milky oolong”, this tea’s creamy, honeyed flavor is the natural character of a subvariety used for its production.

Da Hong Pao – *Fujian, China* 140
Famous rock tea from Wuyishan, our loose leaf Da Hong Pao (Big Red Robe) is twice roasted over charcoal embers which allows it to develop its signature mineral and smoky character with subtle fruit notes.

BLACK

Zheng Shan – *Fujian, China* 100
The grandfather of Lapsang Souchong – this style of tea is the most sought after smoked tea in all of China. Delicate and wiry black tea leaves are smoked with pine boughs for a complex and full yet smooth experience.

Jin Jun Mei – *Fujian, China* 120
This black tea from the lapsang subvariety has been left unsmoked and tastes of berries, rum and raisins.

SAKE MEETS TERROIR

Similar to the natural wine revolution that has transformed many wine producing regions, the Japanese sake industry is undergoing a profound shift in values as breweries are being passed on to sons and daughters. From growing and polishing their own organic rice and embracing heirloom rice varieties to resurrecting ancient brewing techniques, many in this new generation are betting their livelihoods on artisanship and terroir, and we are proud to serve their incredible sake.

SPARKLING

Masumi 真澄 "Origami" Junmai Ginjo – Nagano, Japan 750

MIYOSHINO JOZO 美吉野醸造 花巴 – Nara

Fourth-generation owner Hashimoto Teruaki became the master brewer at Miyoshino Jōzō in 2008, and has since turned it into one of Japan's most innovative and creative breweries. Hashimoto sees sake brewing as part of the local agriculture, working closely with nearby farmers and adjusting his sake to the rice they grow, not the other way around, as it is in most breweries.

Hanatomoe "Jun Dai Dai" – a rare daiginjo produced in traditional Yamahai method 800

Hanatomoe "Mizumoto" – an ancient sake brewing technique brings vibrant acidity to this junmai 700

Hanatomoe "Koshu" – brewed in 1988, this is a rare example of aged sake with incredible stories to tell – 375 ml 1,200

AKISHIKA SHUZO 秋鹿酒造 秋鹿 – Osaka

When Hiroaki Oku took over his 123-year old family brewery fifteen years ago, he set a new ambitious production target – minus 75 percent. Each year he gets closer to that goal, and Akishika sake get rarer. Oku-san's reasoning is simple: he wants to use only the very best rice, and to be at the helm of every step of the process. He's aiming for what he calls "ikkan-zukuri", meaning production from seedling to sake.

Nyukon Itteki – the rice for this junmai daiginjo comes from rice paddies grown organically by Oku-san himself 1,100

Ikkkan Zukuri – a wonderfully complex junmai daiginjo brewed in 2007 and allowed to develop since 2,400

TERADA HONKE 寺田本家 – Chiba

"Terada Honke is a home base for brewers and microorganisms working energetically in tandem with each other", – Masaru Terada's almost spiritual attention to honoring the invisible forces that help him produce some of Japan's most unique sake sets him apart from his peers.

Gonin Musume "Shizen no Manma" – junmai kimoto brewed using heirloom organically grown Kamenoo rice 800

Shin – a very special junmai kimoto brewed in celebration of Terada Honke's 350 years of artisanship 1,400

Kioke Jikomi – a rare junmai brewed in large wooden vats abandoned by most producers in the face of modernity 900

ASIAN WINE REVOLUTION

From Emma Gao's electric wines from biodynamically farmed vineyards at the edge of the Gobi desert and Ian Dai's experiments with natural winemaking all over China to Takahiko Soga's dream "to create a Pinot Noir with a Japanese soul", Asian wine culture is undergoing a massive paradigm shift before our eyes, and we invite you to taste it.
